- Welcome to guests: Haydon Smith (Burnie Surf Lifesaving Club), Leanne Cullen (Somerset RC) and Liz Kinnear-Tarte (Burnie West RC)
- DG Heather has asked three clubs – Burnie, Burnie West & Somerset – to join with Nestlé in promoting this year's Burnie Ten footrace. Haydon thanked the club and said this money would mean the Surf Club is *close* to being able to purchase a new IRB (Inflated Rescue Boat) to replace their very *old* boat. An IRB costs around \$19,000 – *without* the motor!
