- I will also circulate a newsletter from Giant Steps; it is quite a while since we received any news from that organisation.

- Regarding the new Regionalism plan, come September all members will be invited to input their opinions on this plan.
- There are only a few towns that display “Rotary” signs; such signs are usually not in conformance with the official RI logo. We will discuss this with Burnie West and Somerset clubs.
- As mentioned last week, DG Heather had requested that Burnie, Burnie West & Somerset clubs develop a plan in support of Nestlé’s decision to promote this year’s Burnie Ten footrace. Nestlé will supply \$5,000 *plus* 384 large tins of Milo, each tin with an image depicting a race scene. Clearly, the intention is for the clubs to turn the offer into a benefit to the local community.
